### **PURPOSE**

The City Council ordered the November 08, 2016 Special Election on August 16, 2016 by adopting Resolution No. 16-021R for the purpose of calling a Special Election to be held on the proposal to rededicate the use of the section 4b sales and use tax to General Revenue at the rate of 1/8 percent for the purpose of Economic and Community Development for the City of Leon Valley; and authorizing the City Manager to contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator for the conduct of said election, and providing details relating to the conduct of holding the election.

Accordingly, the November 08, 2016 Special Election was held jointly with Bexar County. This communication serves as transmittal to the back-up information and analysis based on voter activity, including early voting and the actual November 08, 2016 Election Day results.


