The bids for this project have been opened, and it appears that TCL Construction Enterprises, LLC is the lowest responsible bidder, with a total bid price of \$986,220. The bid tabulation has been sent to TxDOT for their concurrence. Once we receive their concurrence, the item will be placed on the City Council agenda for the award. Trail construction can begin once we receive the signed contracts. The trail will run adjacent to El Verde Road.

Year 6 Street Maintenance

The City Engineer will start designing a bid package for Year 6 Street Maintenance. Staff is reviewing the street ranking list to decide which streets are to be included in this round. We expect to bid this project in January of 2023.

Huebner Wellsite Generator Project

The bid opening for the Huebner Elevated Storage Tank was held on, October 11th, and we will take this item to City Council for award on November 15th. This is the last elevated tank that needs to be rehabilitated and repainted. After award, a project schedule will be developed.

Code Amendments

Staff is working with the City Attorney to revise the Sustainability Overlay District regulations pertaining to building construction materials, color, and style to ensure we comply with state law. Once this is complete, we will take this back to the City Council for an amendment to the Code and consider uses allowed in the B-3 zoning district with Sustainability Overlay zoning, with or without a Specific Use Permit. Once this is reviewed and revised, we will construct a timetable for completion.

PUBLIC WORKS

- Staff is working on creating a school crossing zone on Huebner Road, from just north of Redbird to just before Chapparal. The zone would encroach into the City of San Antonio, so we would need their permission to install signage and slow the traffic to 20 mph. Staff expects to take this to City Council on December 6th.
- Staff has contacted Bexar County Public Works about piggybacking off of their contracts for street maintenance and other work projects. Staff will be bringing an Interlocal Agreement to City Council for their consideration.
- Staff submitted a grant request for funding of the creation of a transportation plan to support the Safe Streets for All initiative.
- The Park Commission is working on a design process for a skate park to be located at the Shadow Mist Park site.

- Staff and the City Engineer are working on the Huebner Creek Hike & Bike Trail Segment II.
- Staff and the City Engineer have identified segments of the water line along El Verde Road for replacement. The second segment has begun.
- Staff is getting quotes for pool plastering, a rock-climbing wall, and pickle ball accessories.
- Refacing stop signs city-wide, replacing other traffic control signs as needed.
- Pouring a driveway approach on El Verde.
- Installing landscape timbers around a tree on Stirrup.
- Install holiday decorations at Community and Conference Centers, and at City Hall.
- Replacing malfunctioning meters.
- Repairing water leak at Conference Center.
- Replacing cub stops on Huebner and on Autumn Chase.
- Tapping the water main on Huebner to bring water to Old Mill Park for the trees.
- Performing locates along Bandera Road for CPS Energy.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department will be participating in a live fire training drill at San Antonio College on November 12 and 13. We are very excited to participate in this training with other departments in our area.
- The Fire Department will be renewing the City's NFPA FireWise community accreditation at the beginning of November.
- The Fire Department will have a new Paramedic, Ian Shaw, starting on November 28th. He will be completing his firefighter certification within the next 12 months.
- The Fire Department has received and placed into service 15 additional radios. All fire department radios are now P25 compliant. The fire department has enough radios for each staff member.
