**Seneca West Drainage Project**

Engineering and design work continues on the Seneca West Drainage Project. The proposed alignment has been sent to the San Antonio River Authority (SARA) for their approval. The 95% plans have also been submitted to Bexar County for their review. Once the San Antonio River Authority (SARA) approves a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR), bids for the project may be advertised. The dates for the project bid have changed, as we are waiting on approval from SARA. We did receive comments from SARA and prepared our answers/corrections. We submitted revisions to SARA and are now waiting for final approval and permit issuance.

**Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)- Blacksmith Water & Sewer**

**Code Amendments**

6417 Evers Road – SUP to allow a “Restaurant - Not Fully Enclosed and With Sales of Alcohol”. This case was presented to the P & Z on March 22<sup>nd</sup> and then to the City Council on April 5<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.
