Public Works

Projects

- Garren Construction continues this week with the remodel of the Community Center. The
 contractor will finish installing the new grease interceptor and kitchen equipment this week. The
 new projector and screen have been ordered.
- o The Grass Hill Elevated Tank Rehabilitation Project is now complete and the well is back in service. The new logos look great especially at night!
- The contractor for the Marshall Elevated Tank Rehabilitation Project will start his work on April
- Engineering and design work continues on the Seneca West Drainage Project. The proposed alignment will be sent to the San Antonio River Authority (SARA) and the Corp of Engineers for their approval. The Texas Historical Commission has mandated that we obtain a Texas Antiquities Permit and perform archeological work in this area.
- o The Year 4 Street Maintenance Project will be advertised for bids shortly. Once they have been received, verified, and tabulated, the item will go to City Council for bid award.
- Staff has submitted an application for an Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) reimbursement grant for the construction of the second portion of the Huebner Greenway Trail, from Bandera Road to Evers Road. The application was due April 1 and the results will be announced in August of this year.
- The City was awarded a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$318,960 for the Settlers Ridge and Blacksmith Water and Sewer Main Replacement Project.
 The City Engineer and staff will prepare the design and construction plans and then advertise for bids.
- Staff prepared cost estimates for consideration of fluoride in our water supply and will take this item to City Council on April 6 for their consideration.
- Staff has prepared a water system workshop presentation for Council consideration at their April 10 meeting date.
- o Staff is working on the budget for FY 2021-22.
- o Staff will be applying for another CDBG reimbursement grant from the County to replace water and sewer mains on the remaining portion of Blacksmith Drive in the Old Mill subdivision.
- o The Crew will be constructing a basketball court at The Ridge at Leon Valley Park.
- o Performing trash removal and clean up at the parks after the Easter weekend festivities.
- o The Crew repaired railings on the bridge behind Public Works.
- We are continuing with remodeling the City Hall Annex at 6401 El Verde. The roof has been replaced, sheetrock is in and we are painting, installing lights, cabinets, and kitchen equipment.
- o Mowing Bandera Highway this week, then starting Mow Zone 1.
- o The Crew began street sweeping the Ridge at Leon Valley subdivision.

- o The Pool Advisory Committee met at 7 pm on April 5, 2021, at Public Works.
- The Park Commission will meet on April 8 at Raymond Rimkus Park pavilion at 6:30 pm.

- The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints men's club will meet on Saturday, April 17 and Saturday, April 24 at the Silo Park and at the Old Mill Park to plant 100 trees. We sincerely appreciate their help!
- Assistant Director is attending monthly Technical Advisory Committee meetings for the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization and attended Regional Water Resource Development Group (RWRDG) meeting.
- o Staff is attending workshops on the Bandera Road redevelopment concepts.
- The Earthwise Living Day Committee received a Proclamation to declare the month of March as Earthwise Living Month. Various activities were posted on our website and social media, and a tree giveaway was held on Saturday, March 27, from 9 am to noon at the Community/Conference Center grounds, with 200 trees having been "rehomed". Ms. Elaine Valdez was the winner of the free fruit tree giveaway.
