Public Works

- Projects
 - The contractor for the Bexar County LC-17 Huebner Creek Conveyance Flood Control Project has reached substantial completion of the project. They will finish up the remaining punch list items and then JMI Contracting will be in charge of tree planting and mitigation maintenance.
 - O Garren Construction continues with the remodel of the Community Center. The staff has ordered the new kitchen equipment, which should be delivered in about one week. Colors for the flooring, and the interior and exterior walls have been chosen. The exterior of the building and front porch has been painted.
 - Staff and the City Engineer are working on rewrites to the sub-division code. The code needs to be updated to reflect the new rainfall intensities, newer construction regulations for utilities and drainage and the construction exhibits. Also changed will be the cost threshold for the requirement to install sidewalks on older properties. This should be presented to City Council in February.
 - o The contractor for the Grass Hill Elevated Tank Rehabilitation Project continues their work. This project should be completed in about two weeks.
 - o Bids for the John Marshall Elevated Storage Tank Rehabilitation Project were opened Tuesday, January 5. They will go to City Council for award on February 2, 2021.
 - Staff continues to work on an Americans with Disabilities (ADA) transition plan for all City-owned facilities. An article requesting the public's help was posted in the newsletter, on the city website, and on social media sites. An ADA certified Inspector visited each site and we are expecting his report.
 - o Engineering and design work continues on the Seneca West Drainage Project. The proposed alignment was sent to the San Antonio River Authority (SARA) for their approval.
 - The Year 4 Street Maintenance Project will be advertised for bids shortly. Once they have been received, verified, and tabulated, the item will go to City Council for a bid award.
 - Staff is getting the Kinman House ready for the next restaurant tenant to occupy. They hope to open the last week in February.
 - Staff is working on a submittal for an Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) reimbursement grant to hopefully construct the second portion of the Huebner Greenway Trail, from Bandera Road to Evers Road.
 - The City was awarded a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$318,960 for the Settlers Ridge and Blacksmith Water and Sewer Main Replacement Project.
 We will prepare a City Council item for acceptance and a budget adjustment.

- The Crew is continuing to replace the trail at the Silo Park. The old road millings have been removed and base material added. They have repaired all low areas and new asphalt is being installed.
- The Crew is in the process of demolition and removal of the old house at the city-owned Samaritan Drive property.
- The Crew is remodeling the new building at 6401 El Verde. We are calling this building the City Hall Annex.
- o The Crew repaired the fence at City Hall.
- The Crew completed scheduled maintenance work at the City Hall Low Impact Design (LID)
 Parking Lot. We will later be planting sod around the perimeter.
- o Street sweeping continues in the major rights-of-way. I completed the Grass Valley subdivision last week and will be completing the Linkwood subdivision this week.
- o The Crew is replacing dead water meters in the Linkwood subdivision.
- o The Water Crew is waiting on lab supplies for scheduled lead/copper testing.
- The Water Crew is monitoring the Grass Hill elevated storage tank re-painting. Progress has been slow the past week due to the weather; however, progress is still moving forward. The interior has been holiday tested and touched up, and the finish coat was sprayed from the balcony down. The containment was removed to allow the Crew to prep the roof for the finish coat.
- o Repaired a main break on El Verde Rd., and returning this week to replace a section of the old water main with new C-900 PVC.
- The Crew is waiting on delivery of new vehicle washing equipment should be installed on January 27.

Meetings/Events

- Staff is attending bi-monthly webcast meetings with the US Corp of Engineers to discuss the flood reduction feasibility study of Huebner Creek. This project is nearing the finish line and we hope to have a report to City Council by the end of February 2021.
- Assistant Director is attending monthly Technical Advisory Committee meetings for the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, and attended Regional Water Resource Development Group (RWRDG) meeting.
- o Staff is attending workshops on the Bandera Road redevelopment concepts.
