Public Works

- Projects
 - The contractor for the LC-17 Flood Project is delayed in the creek bed, as it's fairly wet; however, the soils haul off is still ongoing. They are still most likely looking at a completion date at the end of September. Their goals this week are as follows:
 - Continue stockpile haul off (this should be complete this week)
 - Fine grade station 135 to 130, and continue select fill spread
 - Complete installation of aquatic plants
 - Repair any washout areas & aquatics with stone rip rap
 - Seed where needed
 - The FY 2020 Street Maintenance Project continues with the ADA ramps being constructed in the Canterfield neighborhood. Citizens are now able to view current capital projects, as well as those completed, by visiting the city's website at http://www.leonvalleytexas.gov/government/public works/capital projects.php.
 - The City will be receiving \$1,346,000 from Bexar County to complete a flood remediation project in the Seneca West area. Surveying and engineering have been completed, and plans are being developed.
 - We will be starting construction of the landscaping and irrigation in the vacant lot at Peachtree and Poss. Tiger will be donating all of the plantings at no cost to the City.
 - The HALT flood gates along Evers and Poss Roads are now fully operational and have now been uploaded to the Bexar County flood gate map! The flood map can be reached at https://www.bexarflood.org/#!/main/map. These new gates will flash, open, and close on their own as they sense floodwaters rising. City Staff will be notified by cell phone when the waters are 6" below the bridge on Evers, then at the bridge, over the bridge, and finally, as the water starts to recede.
 - The City Engineer/Architect prepared plans and specifications for the Community Center remodel. The project was scaled back and rebid, as the costs for the entire remodel were too high. Bids will be opened on September 1, 2020. The staff is getting quotes for the new kitchen equipment.
 - Bids have been advertised for the FY 2020-21 Grass Hill Elevated Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation Project and will be opened on September 1st. We expect this project to start in mid-November, when water usage is lower.
 - Staff and the City Engineer are working on rewrites to the sub-division code. This should be presented to City Council in October.

- O Staff will be reviewing and storing/destroying records, according to the State Library's Records Retention Schedule.
- o The Crew is continuing to replace the asphalt trail in the Old Mill Park.
- o The Crew will start on repairs to the Silo Park Trail, once the Old Mill Park Trail is complete.
- o Performing trash removal and clean up at the parks.
- We Disinfecting all playgrounds, restrooms, outdoor fitness equipment at all parks.
- o The Crew mowed in Mow Zone 1 (Evers/Poss/Huebner, drainage ways).
- o The trees at the Forest Oaks pool will be treated to prevent Oak Wilt.
- o The Crew repaired all window and door trim at the Conference Center.
- o The Crew trimmed trees at the park and at the Community/Conference Center grounds.
- o The Crew removed the fence at The Ridge at Leon Valley Park.
- The Crew will start on the destruction of records storage building once utilities have been removed.
- o The Crew sprayed for mosquitos city-wide.
- o The Crew installed a meter at the Peachtree vacant lot for the new landscaping project.
- o The Crew buried the irrigation line at the rain garden in Raymond Rimkus Park.
- Televising a broken sewer main located in the Seneca Creek easement and obtaining quotes to replace it.

Training

- O Staff will receive 3 hours of safety training by an OSHA certified trainer. Topics will include Hazardous Communication, trenching/excavation safety, safe vehicle backing, roadway and mowing safety, and electrical safety.
- Maintenance Crew Foreman Michael Tristan took the class to become a Licensed Irrigation Technician and is now waiting to find an open testing facility. There may be one available in Austin.
- o Training Crew Leaders on how to operate new tire changing equipment, once installed.
