SUBJECT: Bi-Weekly Update

#### Human Resources

- Three vacant Patrol Officer positions
  - New hire will start on May 9, 2016.
  - One applicant is in background check phase.
  - The third vacancy is currently being advertised.
- One vacant Firefighter position
- The applicant that initially accepted the Animal Control and Code enforcement officer position withdrew his application. Second interviews are being conducted today, April 29, 2016.
- The City has received 91 applications for the full-time receptionist position. Interviews will begin the second week in May.

#### Public Works

- Submitted documents for grant application at CDBG for new water line on Conestoga
- Preparing for city-wide drainage plan for the May 7<sup>th</sup> workshop
- Removed broken sidewalks along Cades Cove in anticipation of tree removal. Once removed, new sidewalks will be constructed
- Installed 8 new stop signs in Canterfield. This area was vandalized last week and the signs were stolen.
- Installed pedestrian crosswalk bollards and lit signs at Evers and Canterfield
- Working on preparations for the Pet Parade to be held May 14th, from 9 am to 11 am.
- Working on Linkwood Addition overgrown grass complaints the rains have accelerated grass and weed growth
- Working on preparations for the Neighborhood Renewal Program, to be held May 21st, from 8 am to 12 noon

#### **Police Department**

- Arrests in Linkwood area. Two individuals were cited for possession of alcohol and narcotics paraphernalia. Four individuals located down the street were found with marijuana and a .22 cal revolver. The driver of a vehicle in this area was arrested for unlawful carrying and possession of marijuana.
- Emergency Detention at an apartment complex.
- Officer Regina Regino has completed the FTO program and will be assigned a shift.

• Detained individuals who had stolen mail in San Antonio. SAPD notified and took custody of the subjects.

## Fire Department

- The City of Leon Valley will be surveyed by the Insurance Services Office on May 4<sup>th</sup>. This survey is administered through FEMA and will include a comprehensive evaluation of the City of Leon Valley's overall floodplain management. Recent improvements will result in a score that may work to lower the cost of flood insurance to property owners. We expect to know the score within 30 days.
- New EMS Medical Director and Partnership begins with Dr. Manifold and the University of Texas Health Science Center – San Antonio on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Several updates and training classes have been scheduled with LVFD Paramedics. The transition is going smoothly and without any issues.
- Chief Valdez has returned from Columbus Ohio and completed the pre-build workshop of the City's new fire engine. The Sutphen Corporation reviewed every detail and component on the new fire engine and the fire engine is set to be delivered in late August.
- The Fire Department will be performing a live test fire and inspection of the new 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks display test site on May 11<sup>th</sup> at 1PM. The department will work closely with the chosen vendor to ensure for a safe event.
- Community Emergency Response Team Training Class 6:00 p.m. 10:00 p.m. Leon Valley Fire
  Department (6300 El Verde) The Leon Valley Fire Department, Bexar County office of Emergency
  Management and Castle Hills Fire Department are partnering to conduct a CERT training class and we
  are searching for eager volunteers! CERT stands for Community Emergency Response Team. Using
  training learned in the classroom and during hands on exercises, CERT volunteers can assist others in
  their community following a disaster when professional responders are not immediately available to
  help. CERT volunteers are also encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking an active
