SUBJECT: Weekly Update

Smoke in the Air: We have received phone calls regarding the smoke in and around Leon Valley starting on Thursday. The smoke is the result of a controlled burn at Guadalupe State Park and is expected to continue for the next several days. The amount of smoke will vary depending on wind conditions. Individuals sensitive to air quality should take extra care when outside, and remain indoors whenever possible.

<u>Appointments to Key Positions</u>: As you know, we have been in the process of recruiting a Planning Manager and a Communications Director.

• <u>Communications Director Appointment</u>: After an extensive hiring process we have selected Mr. Darrick Green as the Communications Director. Mr. Green will be responsible for all communication activity including dispatch and information technology communications. His first day will be February 23, 2015. Please see his biography below:

Prior to joining the City of Leon Valley, Darrick Green spent nearly a decade working in Local Government Administration overseeing various operational departments. As an Assistant City Manager he successfully redesigned operational units to address audit citations and in effective policies and procedures. Darrick's ability to analyze functions and implement change management techniques has repeatedly resulted in rapid transformation of poor preforming units to Best Practice Models, preventing the recapture of nearly \$1.5 million of Federal Grant Funds, which was recognized by State Officials in New Jersey and Florida.

In his spare time Darrick has volunteered as a Wrestling Coach accounting for several Individual All-Americans, State Champions and Team Titles.

Darrick is a Master in Public Administration & Bachelor of Science Degree holder from Central Michigan University, as well as a 2006 Hall of Fame Inductee from Portage Northern HS in Portage, MI.

• <u>Planning Manager Appointment</u>: Also, after an extensive hiring process we have selected Ms. Elizabeth Carol as the new Planning Manager over the Community Development Office. Ms. Carol replaces Kristie Flores and her first day will be March 2, 2015. Following is her biography:

In 2010 she became a member of the American Institute of Certified Planners. She is a graduate of Southwest Texas State University with a Bachelor of Arts and a Master in Geography – Environmental Management.

In her free time, Ms. Carol is training for a half marathon, reading and spending time with family. Ms. Carol looks forward to continuing her commitment of public service for the citizens of Leon Valley.

<u>VIA Metro Transit Grant for Concrete Street Bus-Pads</u>: Staff has been in discussions with staff from VIA concerning the use of grants funds for the installation of concrete street bus-pads along Evers Road, Huebner Road & Poss. The installation of concrete bus-pads along roadways is a good way to extend and improve overall quality of the streets. City staff and VIA staff is in the process of identifying high priority locations in Leon Valley. There is a good possibility that they will fund the installation of the bus-pads on Evers Road as a part of the rehabilitation project scheduled for completion this year. They have also provided detail construction plans for the pads that can be incorporated in our bid package for Evers Road.
