SUBJECT: Weekly Update

<u>Serious Accident in Front of Kinman House</u>: Last night, Leon Valley first responders were called to a motorcycle accident on Evers Rd, in front of the Kinman house. A woman driving a vehicle pulled onto Evers Rode from Sunlight Drive and hit two motorcycles with a total of 3 passengers. The motorcycle passengers were thrown from their motorcycles and were in critical condition upon LV EMS arrival. LV EMS arrived on scene in 2 minutes, transported 3 patients to University Hospital. One of the patients suffered a skull fracture and remains in critical condition. There was a large crowd of nearby residents/on-lookers that witnessed the emergency response. Our Fire, Police, and Dispatch staff did an outstanding job.

<u>Code Enforcement Position:</u> At the City Council meeting—staff was asked to proceed quickly on filling the vacant code enforcement position. Following our personnel hiring procedures, we began advertisement for the Animal Control/Code Enforcement Officer and the advertisement ends March 25, 2015. We should have someone on board by the second week of April.
