SUBJECT: Pre-City Council Meeting Report

Projects

In addition to outside agency review constraints, these projects may also be delayed by weather and supply chain slowdowns.

Public Works

- Staff presented the Capital Improvements Plan to the City Council on October 19th. A short presentation was held in November on potential funding from the Texas Water Development Board and the EPA. This item will be presented to the Town Hall meeting participants in January of 2025.
- The replacement of the storefront glass and doors at City Hall near Council Chambers is complete.
- The final draft of the Park Master Plan was recommended for approval by the Park Commission on December 12th. The Plan will be presented to the City Council and the public in January. We expect it to be placed on the city website for 30 days to gather any last-minute input from the citizens, then it will go to the City Council for final approval.
- The new dog kennel facility is scheduled to be delivered the first week of February.
- The City Engineer is working on plans for the FY 25 Street Maintenance Project. This year we will tackle a portion of Wurzbach Road.
- Staff is in the process of closing on the purchase of 105-acre feet of water rights.

Additional Public Works Activities

- Finished new Police Impound Lot.
- Crack sealing trail at Raymond Rimkus Park.
- Mowing in Mow Zone 1 (Poss/Evers).
- Watering trees along hike & bike trail
- Reading meters.
- Setting new meters.
- Replacing dead meters.
- Die testing sewer service line in Linkwood.
- Decommissioning an old dump truck for auction.

- Will start work on dog kennel foundation.
- Performing reconnects and locking out unpaid account meters.
- Taking water samples.
- Flushing dead end mains.
- Replacing commercial meters.
- Running water line for new kennels.
- Replacing tires on loader and maintainer.

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PW GRANTS

- The engineer continues designing the El Verde Water Main Replacement Project. This project will be funded by a \$1,300,000 Bexar County ARPA grant.
- Awarded a Bexar County CDBG grant for replacing the sewer main in the alley between Cammie Way and Evers Rd project is being engineered, designed, and will then be advertised for bids.
- The City Engineer received direction from the City Council to follow a new alignment for the Huebner Creek Erosion Control Project and has redesigned it to follow the existing creek. Staff applied for a Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Flood Infrastructure Fund (FIF) grant and a FEMA Flood Mitigation (FMA) grant for project funding.
- The CDBG East of Wurzbach Sewer Main Replacement Project bids were opened last week and the City Engineer has reviewed them and made a recommendation. This item will go to City Council in January for award.
- Bexar Branches Alliance is assisting the city with the submittal of a \$110,000 grant to plant 600 trees in the Huebner-Onion Natural Area Park. This will go to the City Council for approval once the details have been finalized.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- With colder weather coming, we would remind all residents that rain and ice cause tree limbs over the street to sag. This sagging obstructs the right of way, delaying emergency vehicles responding to calls. In some cases, completely block emergency vehicles. 403.2.1 Dimensions. Fire apparatus access roads shall have an unobstructed width of not less than 20 feet, exclusive of shoulders, except where a fire hydrant is located on a fire department access road, in which case the minimum road width shall be 26 feet. An unobstructed vertical clearance of not less than 14 feet and shall be required and maintained at all times. Security gates shall be sized to match the required clear width.
- Please remember that the LVFD is always willing to help change smoke detector batteries for residents who need assistance.
- LVFD is currently out testing our fire hydrants throughout the city. We have completed all private fire hydrant and fire line testing at all of our apartment complexes. Remember, fire hydrants and fire lines located on private property is the responsibility of the property owner.
- Blood drive scheduled for December 23, 2024 from 9am to 2pm located at 6400 EL Verde Rd. Leon Valley, 78238- City Hall.
- Fire and Police crews have been given access to two houses that are being demolished in early December. These houses located on Huebner Road are being used to practice all types of firefighting skills short of burning them. In early December, our crews will be practicing roof operations and cutting large holes in the roofs. If you see crews on the roofs and lots of emergency vehicles at these houses, we are just training.



• LVFD Crews attended the annual Christmas Tree Lighting and the Breakfast with Santa. Crews interacted with the kids and showed off some of the fire vehicles to curious children and adults.
