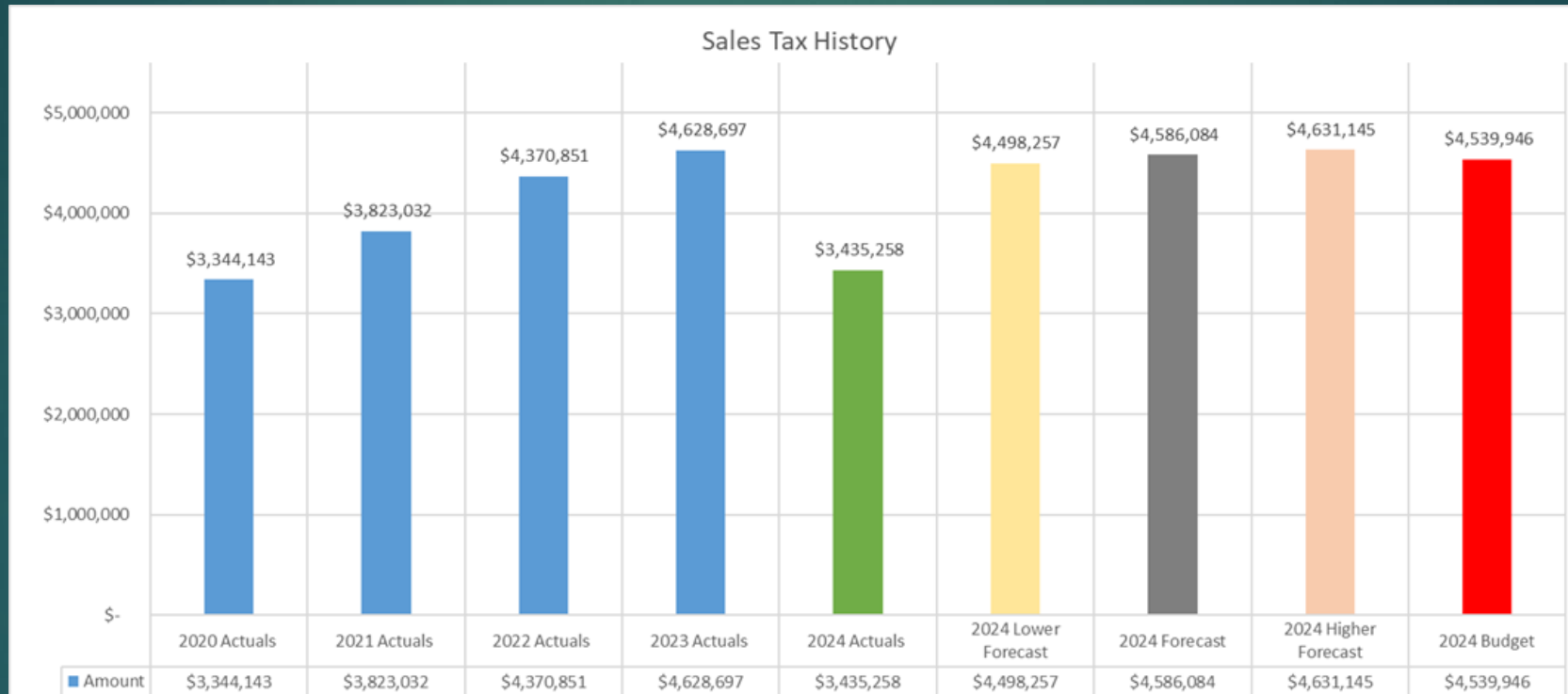

The collection for this month is higher than the 3-year average of \$340,071. Through the period of the fiscal year the City has collected \$3,435,258. This amount is lower than last year's collection of \$3,513,644 by 2.23% or \$78,385

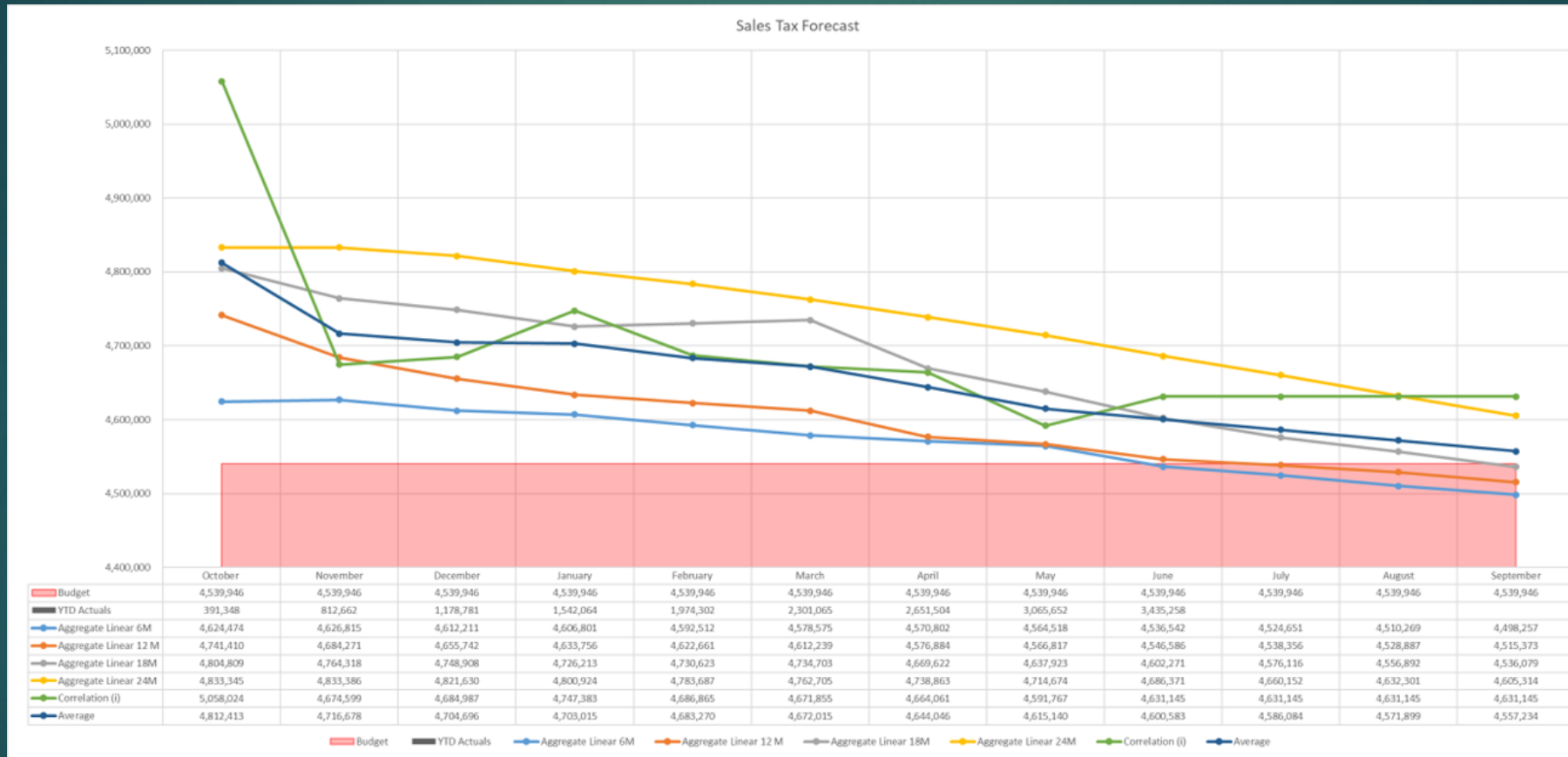
