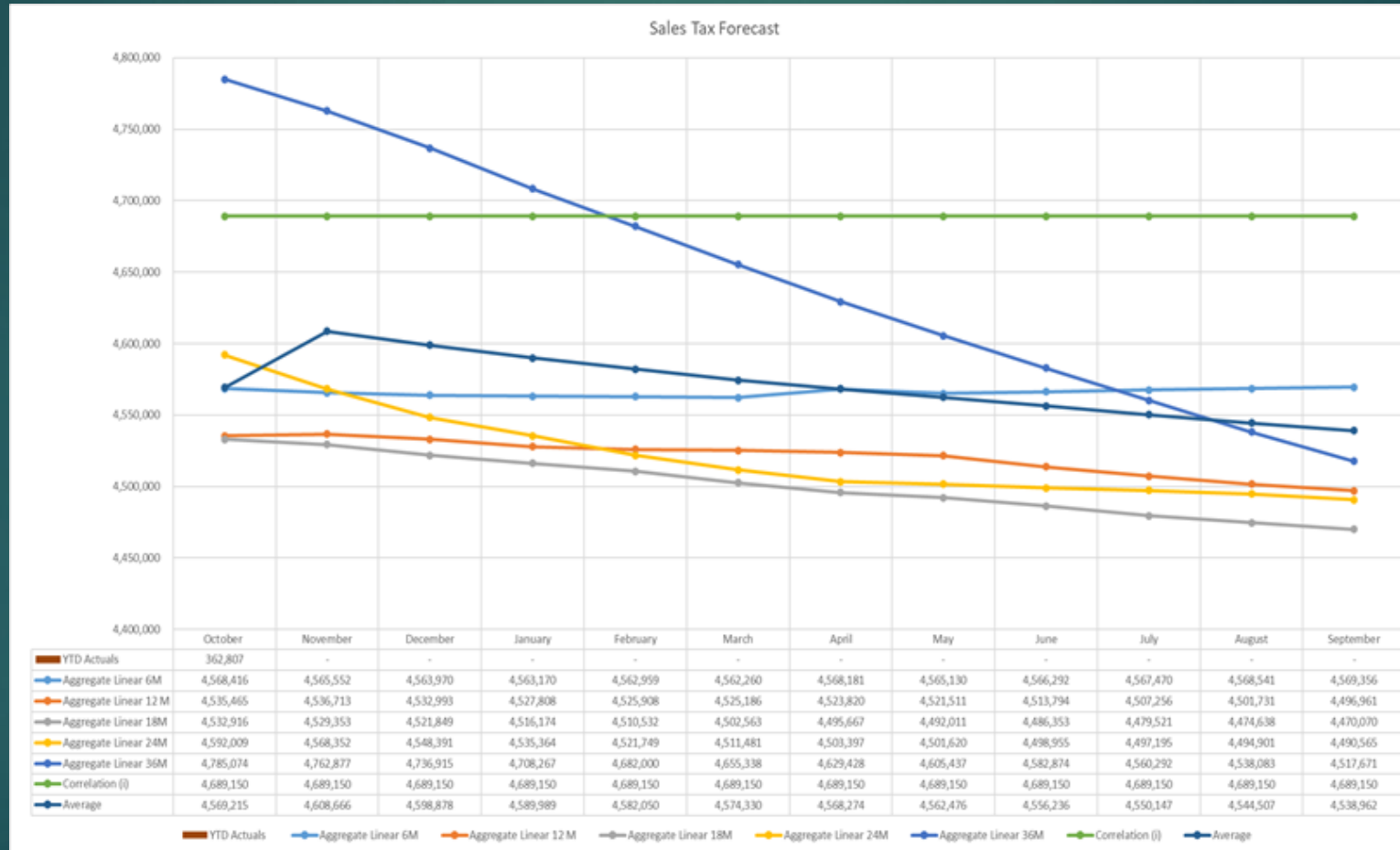
- The November report shows that the city collected \$445,715. This amount is \$24,400 or 5.79% higher compared to the same month last year. The collection for this month is above the 3-year average of
