REDUCE, REFILL, RECYCLE.

Handouts should be printed on recycled paper with soy ink if possible and promote our goals.
Giveaways should reflect the overall environmental theme.
Throwaway items should be avoided.
Avoid plastic items unless they can be recycled.
Use healthy ingredients, decomposable utensils and no beaded Styrofoam please.

Booth Set Up Timeline:

Indoor Set up: - Friday, February 28, 2024, between 11 a.m. - 4 p.m. ONLY. No access will be granted to the building outside of the set hours.

Porch or Outdoor Set up: - On Event Day only. Set up begins at 7:30A.M. and MUST BE COMPLETED BY 9:00 am

Booth TAKEDOWN begins at 1:00 p.m. All Booth Participants must remain in place until after the closing activity.

Indoor booths have a soft fabric partition/backdrop to hang signs or information on or you can use your own display.
