**Please Comment on Bandera Road Redevelopment Options
By July 21st: Boulevard or Parkway?**

Thank you for everyone who attended the in-person meeting on July 14th at the Leon Valley Conference Center to view Texas Department of Transportation's (TXDOT) Bandera Road (SH16) virtual public presentation. This meeting was co-sponsored by the City of Leon Valley and Councilwoman Ana Sandoval, District 7, City of San Antonio. Participants had an opportunity to ask specific questions as it related to the two proposed alternatives, Boulevard or Parkway, with options for intersection improvements, among other information presented. The initial comment period was from June 29th to July 14th; *TXDOT extended the deadline to July 21st to receive comments from interested citizens.*

The virtual public presentation is 35 minutes long. After viewing, there is a card attached for submitting your comments.

TXDOT will compile the input received and present the findings at another public meeting by the end of 2021. Thank you for helping to envision what Bandera Road will look like in 25 years!
