



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT POLICE LIEUTENANT

Patrol, Photographic Traffic Control System and Traffic Safety Programs

Under general supervision of the Assistant Police Chief, leads police personnel assigned to the Photographic Traffic Control System, Traffic Safety Program, Patrol Division, and Investigations Division. This position is responsible for planning, organizing, directing, and supervising the division's activities, including the enforcement of all laws of the City, State, and the United States, carrying out special assignments in the field of police work; provide reports of assignments, and/or do related while providing complex and highly responsible administrative support to the Police Department.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Fifteen years of progressive supervisory experience in law enforcement or related field, with Investigative and Police Patrol experience.
- Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, Criminology, other law enforcement related course of study, or equivalent years of experience and education in law enforcement.
- Texas Licensed Peace Officer with an Advanced Peace Officer Certification from TCOLE.
- Must be able to pass background investigation, psychological evaluation, physical and drug exams.
- Must have a Valid Texas Driver's License.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATION:

- Extra consideration will be given to applicants who have:
 - Bilingual (English/Spanish)
 - Participated in emergency response scenes, to include barricaded subjects, hostage situations, and active shooter scenes.
 - Ten years' experience in traffic management, crime prevention, arrests and court procedures.
 - Field Training Supervisor (FTS) Certification.
