City of Leon Valley Cleaning and Televising Sewer Mains

Leon Valley, May 14, 2024 — The Public Works Department of the City of Leon Valley is pleased to announce a significant infrastructure improvement initiative aimed at enhancing the efficiency and longevity of the city's sewer system. The department has partnered with Cleanview Resources, LLC to undertake the comprehensive cleaning and televising of approximately 35 miles of sewer mains across the city.

Scheduled to commence on Wednesday, May 15, 2024, the project will kick off in the Old Mill neighborhood. Cleanview Resources crews will begin work on Timberhill, spanning from Huebner to the City Limits. Employing state-of-the-art equipment and techniques, the team will utilize pressurized water through a sewer jet head and hose to dislodge any loose debris such as wipes, asphalt, sediment, and grease. Subsequently, a large vac truck will be deployed to remove the debris from the sewer main, ensuring proper disposal in a licensed landfill. Following the cleaning process, a sophisticated camera system will be employed to televise the sewer main, meticulously documenting its condition. This valuable information will be instrumental in assessing the current state of the infrastructure and prioritizing any necessary repairs or maintenance activities.

As this important project unfolds, the City of Leon Valley urges residents and motorists to exercise caution and patience. During the period when crews are actively working in the neighborhood, it is advised to be vigilant while driving around equipment and to be aware that manholes may be temporarily opened. Cleanview Resources staff will be diligently monitoring these areas to ensure safety and efficiency.

In addition, as a precautionary measure during the duration of the project in your neighborhood, residents are encouraged to close toilet lids and sink and tub drains. This simple step can help prevent any potential issues during the cleaning and televising process.
